Attendance

If your child is unable to attend school due to illness, please ring the school office on 0161 343 6070 (selecting option 1) or e-mail admin@pceps.co.uk on the first day of absence. Please ensure that 48 hours has elapsed after any episode of diarrhoea or vomiting before your child returns to school. School staff will contact parents / carers if we have not been notified, in order that registers may be marked correctly. We ask that wherever possible, appointments are not made during school time. Where this is not possible, please send your child's appointment card / letter into school in advance.
